For many Landmen working in the field questions are raised by Lessors and potential Lessors about drilling, hydraulic fracturing and other techniques employed by producers to recover as much gas and oil from reservoirs as is practical. Fracing has been used by drilling and production companies for many years to maximize well production. In the case of Michigan and other producing states fracing is governed by regulation. Landmen can utilize the many sources of information available through AAPL, MAPL, state regulations and other energy related organizations to educate themselves on current issues and regulations that may cause concerns with some Lessors. The HBO documentary GasLand has stirred interest within the public and that has caused the industry to address some of the specific allegations.
